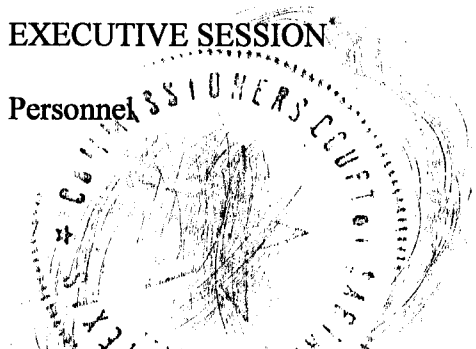
NOTICE OF MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT
